	Once you have a set date for your move organize a removalist. If you need storage arrange it now.
П	Remember to book time off work if needed.
	Collect moving materials such as boxes, packing tape, newspapers etc.
	Keep a list of incoming mail and start notifying businesses and suppliers of your change of address. Australia Post re-direction is strongly recommended.
П	Label all packing boxes with the contents and the room they belong to.
	Make a list of the items you want the removalist to move and any items you'll be moving yourself.
П	Defrost the freezer before moving it.
	Place important documents such as passports and drivers licenses in a safe and secure
	place.
	Be sure to keep all moving related documents together.

Carry valuables, personal items and important papers with you so they don't get lost.
